

New hires at the Sabaf Group

At a time when there is talk of redundancy block and resilience, the **Sabaf Group goes against the tide** and announces new hires. **Over 250 employees were hired from July 2020 to March 2021 and other hires are arriving in the 3 new plants that will be opened by 2023.** And not only new hires, but also rewards



for workers who have faced the pandemic year. In fact, Sabaf decided to pay **an individual bonus of 300 euros in May (in the form of services offered by the corporate welfare platform) to its 700 Italian collaborators.** “The first half of 2020 was a bit complicated – explains the CEO Pietro Iotti – but from July the demand has started to grow again. Today the Group has 1500 employees, of which 250 hired from July to March: among these, 160 in Italy”. “The responsibility and commitment of the collaborators were decisive for successfully facing the 2020 emergency – continues Iotti -: we feel it is our duty to express our gratitude to the people who contributed to the excellent results of the company in such a complicated year”. The numbers speak for themselves: **turnover and margins are growing, with the prospect of reaching 240 million in 2021, earlier than established by the industrial plan** (that is 250 million in 2023) and a clear recovery compared to 185 million of 2020 and 155 million of 2019. “The main driver of our growth is the expansion of the range of our products – underlines Iotti – thanks to innovation and acquisitions”.
