Sabaf S.p.A. informs that the Board of Directors is expected to meet on the following days during 2018:

- February 13th - approval of 2017 fourth quarter interim report
- March 26th - approval of 2017 draft financial statements and consolidated financial statements
- May 15th - approval of 2018 first quarter interim report
- August 2nd - approval of 2018 half year report
- November 13th - approval of 2018 third quarter interim report.

The annual general meeting will be called on 8 May 2018 to approve the financial statements as of 31 December 2017.
